



USJ Community Scholarships

The USJ Community Scholarships are gift funds that are donated by various and prominent local institutions and individuals to students with outstanding performance in the previous academic year. These are positive reinforcements for high achievers to continue striving to their optimum potentials.

Eligibility:

Recipients must be regular active students with no outstanding balance in current academic year.

Recipients must be regular full time students in the former year with no retake modules due to failure and their minimum GPA must be at least 15/20.

Applications and selections:

It is not necessary for students to apply for USJ Community scholarships and the University of Saint Joseph Scholarships Committee selects the recipients according to the values and purposes defined by the donors with the confirmation of the programme coordinators. Please refer to the USJ Community Scholarships List to check the criteria defined by the donors.

Announcement:

The result will be announced through USJ media by the Office for Student Affairs in the first semester.

Duties for USJ Community Scholarship Recipients:

1. Students who are granted USJ Community Scholarships must attend the USJ Scholarships and Fellowships Award Ceremony unless justified and approved by the related Committee.
2. Students must sign the Scholarship Agreement (OSA-013) & Acceptance/Decline Form (OSA-015) within 15 days of receiving the official notice from the Office for Student Affairs that they have been awarded USJ Community Scholarship.
3. Students are expected to comply with all USJ policies and guidelines (please refer to the Student Handbook).
