Registration Timeline for International students

1. Preliminary registration opened: April 6
2. Deadline for registration: May 8
3. Acceptance/non acceptance Acknowledgment from USJ: May 20
4. Confirmation from candidate and pay USD\$375 (or MOP/HK\$ 3000): June 10
5. Official acceptance letter and Accommodation information: 5 days after payment of USD\$375 (June 15 the latest)
6. Classes: July 13 to 24

Fees

International Students

- Application/Deposit Fee: USD\$ 375 (or MOP/HK\$ 3000) (non-refundable)
- Remainder: USD\$250 (or MOP/HK\$ 2000)
- Total amount of USD\$ 625 (or MOP/HK\$ 5000)

Macau Residents

Macau candidates may be eligible to the DSEJ subsidy for this course. In that case, the candidate shall come to USJ and bring his/her Macau Permanent Resident ID card to register. The total amount of tuition fee is MOP\$/HK\$ 4300.

Accommodation

Medical Insurance (Mandatory)

In addition to your personal insurance, all incoming students are required to buy “Comprehensive Medical Insurance Plan” with coverage of your medical in Macao. If you consider exploring other destinations in the region other than Macau, your health insurance must provide coverage for the said destination.

Incoming students are responsible for the cost of treatment during their stay in Macao, should any medical emergencies arise, you must therefore have medical insurance coverage as a requirement and verify that the insurance policy you carry covers hospitalization and medical care occurring during international travel and sojourns, as well as repatriation to your home country in case of medical emergency.

Note: If you have an allergic condition, it would be wise to bring your medication with you, also a doctor’s prescription for additional medication if required.
