- Transcript of records.
- Passport copy with an expiry date of more than six months after the end of the exchange period.
- Recent passport-sized photo (1.5 inch full-face on a white background, in electronic format (tiff, jpeg) less than 512KB).
- Health certificate.
- Tetanus vaccination Record.
- Motivation Letter in support of the application to participate in the USJ Exchange Programme.

Note: Once accepted as an Incoming exchange student in USJ it is **MANDATORY to purchase comprehensive international health insurance with coverage of your length of study**. If you consider exploring other destination sin the region than Macau, your health insurance must provide coverage for any consider destination, i.e. should you wish to visit Thailand, Philippines, or etc, during your holidays, your international health insurance must extend the coverage to these regions.
