- Scanned copy of the passport (ID page)
- Scanned copy of the Transcript of Records
- E-mail, telephone number, course/programme of studies and intended mobility period

ONLINE APPLICATION BY THE STUDENT

After we confirm the reception of the Home Institution's nomination, we will send an email to the nominated students with the application process and deadlines.

MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION

USJ courses are all taught in English with the exception of Chinese and Portuguese modules.

LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

USJ uses the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages. All accepted incoming exchange students must demonstrate proficient command of English (B2).

FEEES FOR INCOMING EXCHANGE STUDENTS

Incoming exchange students from any of USJ's partner institutions do not have costs associated with USJ tuition fees or application fees, unless mentioned in the partner agreement.

WORKLOAD PER SEMESTER

This is according to the requirements set-forth by the Home Institution. The incoming exchange students are entitled to the selection of courses according to their needs.

GRADING SYSTEM

Grades are typically submitted through MyUSJ within one month of the last session or exam date. Modules are graded on a numerical scale ranging from 0 (fail) to 20 (excellent).

USJ RESIDENTIAL HALL

COST OF LIVING

Usually, a minimum of MOP 5,000 (approximately USD\$625 or EUR\$560) per month can cover basic living expenses. Below are some estimated costs for reference only:

Transportation:	Bus: MOP130 (Macau Pass smart card - 100 credit & 30 deposit) Taxi: MOP19 (for first 1,600 meters)
Fitness Room	Free of charge for USJ students and USJ Residential Hall residents
Books	MOP150~500 <i>*USJ Library has hard copies for loan and soft copies are available in USJ Library's online resources</i>
Entertainment	Movie ticket MOP70~300 <i>*Depends on movie theatre and movie version</i> Museum MOP10~30 <i>*Some museums have free admission</i>
Laundry	A self-service laundry room is located on the 4 th Floor of the Residential Hall. Residents should supply their own laundry powder or detergent.
Postal Services	There are several post offices located across the city as well as express services like DHL and EMS. <i>*Students staying at the Residential Hall can receive mail, including parcels and courier packages directly.</i>

TRAVELLING TO MACAO (**Entry Requirements for Non-Residents:** <https://bit.ly/30GZrAn>)

- **By Air:** Macau International Airport is a busy airport, offering flights to and from a handful of popular locations in Asia including Japan, Indonesia, Thailand, India and more.
- **By Sea:** Macau Ferry terminal offers ferry rides to and from Mainland China, Central Hong Kong and Hong Kong International Airport. The journey takes roughly one hour.
- **By the Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge:** Macau is now connected to Hong Kong via the longest sea crossing in the world, offering an alternative to the ferry ride. The journey takes roughly 30 minutes.
- **By Land:** Macau borders with Mainland China's Zhuhai. The borders operate from 7AM to midnight, 7 days a week, making the crossing a viable option.

STUDENT'S OBLIGATIONS

After arrival and check-in at the Residential Hall (if applicable), students should approach the Office for Student and Alumni Affairs, located on the 2/F of the Residential Hall Building of the Ilha Verde Campus, to get to know the team and receive basic information on what they should do next. Afterwards, students should head to the Academic Affairs Office, located on the G/F of the Academic Building, with the required original application documents plus the original International Medical Insurance Policy for matriculation and class enrolment.
