Assistant Professor/Associate Professor (Ref. No.: FAH-AP73)

- 4. Candidates with prior experience as University lecturer is preferable;

- 6. Experience with Research Project management and proposal submissions;
- 7. Experience in creating new curricula at Bachelor Level or Master Level:
- 8. Proficiency in Portuguese and English, or Portuguese and Chinese;
- 9. Reading Proficiency in both of the Official Languages of Macau (Traditional Chinese and Portuguese) is preferable;
- 10. Macao ID holder is preferable.
