- 7. Ability to contribute to the formation of strategy and plans at the faculty level, through engagement with the Dean and faculty colleagues, conducting environmental scanning, and assessing opportunities and risks;
- 8. Publications in peer-reviewed journals;
- 9. Proficient in English and Chinese;
- 10. Macao ID holder is preferable.
